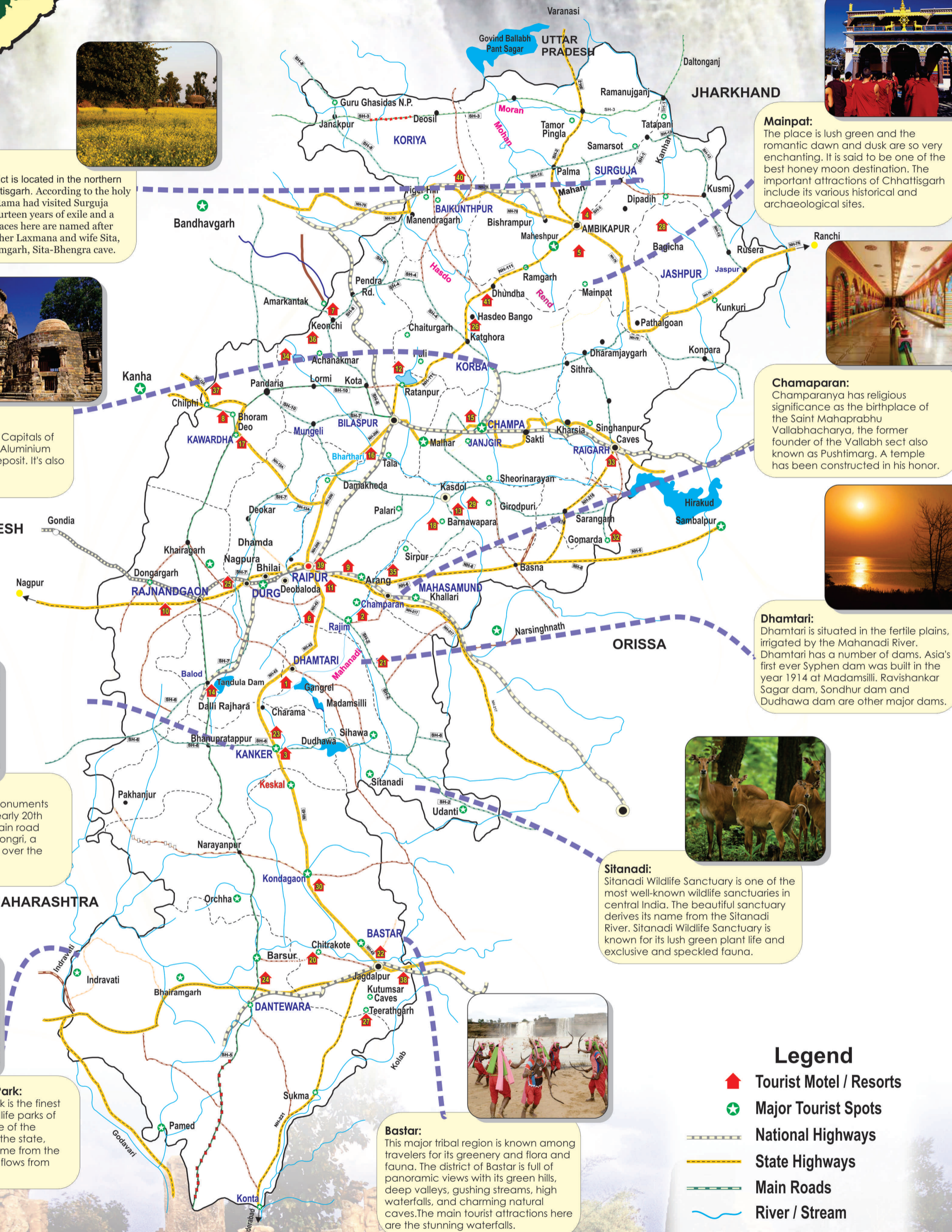


Kanker:
Kanker is dotted with monuments from the 19th and the early 20th Centuries. From the main road can be seen the Qila Dongri, a majestic hill that towers over the river.

Indravati National Park is the finest and most famous wildlife parks of Chhattisgarh. Also one of the three Tiger Reserve in the state. The Park derives its name from the Indravati River, which flows from east to west.

Mainpat:

Champanan:
Champanan has religious significance as the birthplace of the Saint Mahaprabhu Vallabhacharya, the former founder of the Vallabh sect also known as Pushtimarg. A temple has been constructed in his honor.



Dhamtari:
Dhamtari is situated in the fertile plains, irrigated by the Mahanadi River. Dhamtari has a number of dams, Asia's first ever Syphen dam was built in the year 1914 at Madamsilli. Ravishankar Sagar dam, Sondhur dam and Dudhawa dam are other major dams.



Sitanadi:
Sitanadi Wildlife Sanctuary is one of the most well-known wildlife sanctuaries in central India. The beautiful sanctuary derives its name from the Sitanadi River. Sitanadi Wildlife Sanctuary is known for its lush green plant life and exclusive and speckled fauna.



Bastar:
This major tribal region is known among travelers for its greenery and flora and fauna. The district of Bastar is full of panoramic views with its green hills, deep valleys, gushing streams, high waterfalls, and charming natural caves. The main tourist attractions here are the stunning waterfalls.
